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JAISHREE THAKUR J. (ORAL)

The instant writ petition has been filed by invoking Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for revoking suspension order of the petitioner since more than two years have elapsed from the date of his suspension i.e. 28.01.2019.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would contend that vide order dated 04.08.2021, he has been reinstated in service, however, subject to the final disposal of the disciplinary proceedings pending against the petitioner. It is further contended that the petitioner has been served with charge-sheet as far back as 14.06.2019 (P-10) to which he has already filed his response. The limited prayer made presently is for an early conclusion to the proceedings pending against the petitioner.

In view of the innocuous prayer made by the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to conclude the disciplinary proceedings pending against the petitioner within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
