As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹4,05,000/- (₹ Four Lac Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, out of the enhanced amount of ₹4,05,000/-, ₹3,00,000/- be paid to appellant No.1 - Harjit Kaur wife of Kamaljit Singh and remaining ₹1,05,000/- be paid to appellant No.3 – Manjot Singh son of Harpreet Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two crossed-cheques i.e. one for ₹3,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 - Harjit Kaur wife of Kamaljit Singh and another for ₹1,05,000/- in the name of appellant No.3 – Manjot Singh (minor) son of Harpreet Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 15.06.2022, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The

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appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
