The present petition has been filed with a prayer that direction be issued to respondents No. 2 to 4 to stop harassing the petitioners in the guise of enquiry, which is allegedly being conducted with regard to the jumping of parole by Manjit Singh, who is the husband/father of petitioners No. 1 and 2 respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that said Manjit Singh has jumped the parole and is missing and even the petitioners do not know his whereabouts and for that purpose, the statement of not only the petitioners but other family members including the neighbors have also been recorded still, time and again the house of the petitioners is being raided at the odd hours by the police under the guise of the said enquiry. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that once the petitioners and their

family members including neighbors have already given their statements and they do not know the whereabouts of said Manjit Singh and in case, the petitioners are needed for the purpose of any enquiry, the procedure envisaged under the Cr.P.C. should be followed.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions to submit that henceforth, in case the petitioners are needed for any enquiry purpose so as to clarify any doubt, the appropriate procedure as envisaged under the Cr.P.C. will be followed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the said undertaking of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed.

Petition stands disposed of as not pressed.
