Though, the learned counsel representing the petitioner is not present, however, the learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the present revision petition is rendered infructuous as the petitioner-late Sh. Jasbir Singh has already died.

Smt. Amarjit Kaur filed a suit claiming to be the owner of ½ share of the suit property along with her brother Sh. Jasbir Singh. Sh. Jasbir Singh denied that Smt. Amarjit Kaur is her sister. The application filed by Smt. Amarjit Kaur for directing late Sh. Jasbir Singh to undergo the Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) test was allowed. However, as already noticed, late Sh. Jasbir Singh has already died.

In view of the aforesaid, the revision petition is rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
