The Prayer in this petition is for the grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC in case FIR No.23 dated 15.02.2022 under Sections 326, 323, 324 and 34 IPC registered with Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

The Learned Counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits that there were 10 Pws cited to be examined, three of whom have passed away. He submits that out of the remaining 07 witnesses, six stands examined and only Dr. Surinder Bangar is to be examined.

Given the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner have already been acquitted and compromise has been effected between the parties, the trial Court is directed to positively examine Dr. Surinder Bangar on the next date fixed before it.

Disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
