The petitioner is aggrieved because the State of Punjab has issued a communication dated 18.06.2021 (Annexure P-2) to all its Nodal Officers (Scholarship) to submit a report against those institutions who are retaining roll number/certificate/degree of any student on account of non-payment of institutional dues.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that certain students do not pay the tuition fees despite the same having been credited to their respective accounts and thus, the only option available to the institutions is to withhold issuance of roll number/certificate/degree. If action is taken against the institutions on account of the same, they will suffer financially.

The matter can be resolved mutually by holding discussions. No representation has been made to the State as yet. Even an attempt has not been made to raise this issue with the State authorities and thus, this writ petition is not entitled to be entertained.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition with liberty to follow up the matter with the concerned authorities.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforementioned liberty.
