Anil Kshetarpal, J.

1. During the pendency of the execution petition, the petitioner (judgment debtor No.4) was proceeded against *ex parte*. Admittedly, the execution petition is pending. A party, who is proceeded against *ex parte* on a particular date, has a right to join the proceedings and to contest the matter. Admittedly, the decree against the judgment debtor has become final.
2. In such circumstances, the application for setting aside the *ex parte* proceedings are not required to be filed.
3. With the observations made above, the present revision petition is disposed of.
