The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking transfer of investigation of case FIR No.145 dated 05.12.2021 under Sections 307, 323, 34, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Kaithal to State Vigilance Bureau or to any independent agency.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents states that the investigation of the case is already complete and after the filing of the final report, the charge has been framed and evidence of one witness has also been recorded.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. There was no appearance on behalf of the petitioners even on the last date of hearing. It seems that the petitioners have no subsisting grievance.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed for non prosecution.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to seek revival of the present petition in case the grievance subsists.
