The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to open the National Highway that was obstructed on account of ongoing agitation by the farmers..

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submit that the issue is only academic and the petition has been rendered infructuous since the agitation has come to an end and all blockades on the National Highway stand removed.
