In view of the above, without going into the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.4-District Education Officer, New DAC Complex, Barnala, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation (P-10), in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case there is a failure, petitioner shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application before this Court for revival of the petition.
