This is a criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has a married lady and has submitted a representation dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 and in the said representation, she has given the incidents, which would show that there is an apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioner. It is further alleged that the video has been prepared by respondent No.4 and the said video is required to be ceased

from respondent No.4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider the representation dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) only on the aspect of threat to the life of the petitioner and takes appropriate action thereon.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

On advance notice, Mr. Sarabjit Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and on a specific query put by this Court, he has stated that he has no objection in case, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, looks into the representation dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) and takes appropriate action, in accordance with law.

After considering the facts and circumstances of the present case, this Court deems it appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) and after making necessary enquiries, respondent No.2 shall take appropriate action in accordance with law.

In view of what has been observed above, the present criminal writ petition is disposed of in the abovesaid terms.
