An interlocutory order passed by the trial court directing the plaintiff to pay the ad valorem court fee on sale consideration reflected in sale deed dated 23.11.2012 and 09.07.2015 has been questioned by the plaintiff. Admittedly, the petitioner is the executant of the aforesaid documents. As per **Suhrid Singh @ Sardool Singh vs. Randhir Singh and others 2010 AIR (SC) 2807** the ad valorem court fee is payable if the executant prays for annulment of the documents. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

Since the revision petition has remained pending for quite some time, let the deficiency in court fee be made good within a period of one month, from today.
