GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.6 dated 05.01.2020 registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, under Sections 420/120-B IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise stated to have been effected amongst the parties before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre attached to this Court on 01.02.2022 (Annexure P-2).
2. Notice of motion had been issued vide order dated 09.02.2022.
3. Today, Mr. Rajesh Kapila, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3 and has admitted the factum of compromise effected before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre.
4. Learned counsel representing the petitioner has today passed on a demand draft for an amount of Rs.1,15,000/- in compliance of the

condition, as mentioned in Para 6(b) of the compromise deed (Annexure P-2), which has been accepted by the learned counsel for the complainant, who has stated that all the terms of the compromise stand duly complied with and that he has no objection for quashing of the FIR in question. A photocopy of the said draft has been furnished to this Court, which is taken on record.

5. In view of the aforesaid factum of compromise amongst the parties and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.6 dated 05.01.2020 registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, under Sections 420/120-B IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
