Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.196 dated 30.09.2017 under Sections 307, 379-B, 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Sections 379/336 IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail by the trial Court on 27.02.2018 and was regularly appearing, however, on 19.10.2021, he could not appear due to ill-health and his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and face the trial.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed. In case, the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today, he will be released on bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, concerned.

This will, however, be subject to the condition that the petitioner will deposit the costs of Rs.3,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, concerned, for delaying the trial.
