ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (Oral)

The Family Court has directed the petitioner to pay maintenance pendente lite at the rate of Rs.7,000/- per month only. The aforesaid amount was payable during the pendency of the petition for dissolution of the marriage by a decree of divorce. A decree of divorce has already been passed.

The Family Court has passed the order after considering all the aspects of the matter. Though the petitioner claims that his salary is only Rs.8948/- per month, however, the Family Court has, prima facie, found that the petitioner, being an able bodied person and resident of Gurugram, has a higher income than he is stating. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
