Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 03.12.2021 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur, vide which application filed by the petitioner along with co-accused for their discharge from Section 307 IPC in FIR No.186 dated 18.10.2019 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 307, 325, 201 IPC were added later on), Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur, was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has primarily relied upon opinion of the doctor.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, I find that this case is premature, as neither the charges have been framed nor statement of the doctor is recorded.

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Accordingly, this petition is disposed of having been rendered as infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file afresh, after statement of the doctor is recorded.
