Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been placed under suspension because the vehicle which he was driving had met with an accident and resulted in injuries to one person. The petitioner was convicted but he has been granted the benefit of probation. Neither any chargesheet nor any enquiry has been initiated against the petitioner. He also contends that the petitioner has sent a legal notice dated 14.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) for his reinstatement and contends that the petition be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the court, Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

Without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 14.12.2021 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
