This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Certiorari against posting order No.05/2019 dated 09.02.2019 (Annexure P-1), whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be transferred from APS, 1687 Field Post Office, C/o 56 APO to APS 1685 Field Post Office, Shahanjahanpur.

It has been pointed out by the counsel for the parties that the main issue qua the retention of the petitioner into service of respondent Nos.2 to 5; on deputation; is already pending before the Armed Forces Tribunal. In the present petition, only the issue of transfer of the petitioner from one place to another place is involved.

Keeping in view the exigencies of the service in which the petitioner is posted, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more. Hence, the same is dismissed.

However, the petitioner may make a representation before the respondents qua his posting, till the decision of the main aspect by the Armed Forces Tribunal. The said representation, if made by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, shall be considered and decided by the respondents, within a further period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the same.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, is also disposed of as such.
