Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 not to revert the petitioner from the post of a Foreman.

2. Petition was admitted for hearing on 04.04.2003.

3. When taken up for final adjudication, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Vide order dated 21.09.2022, fresh notice was ordered to be sent to the petitioner. Despite service, petitioner chooses not to appear.

4. It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for more than 19 years before this Court, either it has been rendered infructuous or even otherwise the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

5. Be that as it may, writ petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application in case any cause of action still survives.
