Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 12.01.2022, under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 22.02.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 22.02.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He further submits that the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation Centre at District Court Sangrur and both the parties appeared before it and the matter has been finally settled.

The report of the Mediator has also been received showing that the mediation remained successful.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has also affirmed the said fact.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 22.02.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
