[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Articles 226 / 227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Certiorari for setting aside / quashing the result of Physical Screening Test (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner for the post of Sub Inspector, whereby the candidature of the petitioner has been rejected illegally and arbitrarily or in the alternative for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-7) dated 24.10.2021 by passing a speaking order.

[3] Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

[4] Mr. Rajesh Gaur, learned Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and after perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the alternative prayer of the petitioner to decide representation (Annexure P-7) dated 24.10.2021 and states that the same would be decided by the competent authority i.e. respondent

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned Addl. AG, Haryana, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is *disposed of* by directing respondent No.2 to decide representation (Annexure P-7) dated 24.10.2021, in accordance with law, by taking into account all aspects of the matter within 04 weeks from today and to furnish a copy of the decision to the petitioner within 01 week, thereafter.
