The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to fairly investigate the complaints (Annexures P-2, P-4, P-5 & P-6) made by the petitioner alongwith further prayer as mentioned in the prayer clause.

Notice.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions may be issued to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to decide the representations dated 20.04.2021, 28.04.2021, 30.04.2021 & 06.01.2022 (Annexures P-2, P-4, P-5 & P-6 respectively) within the time bound manner.

The prayer is not opposed. Given above, the present petition is **disposed of** by issuing directions to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to decide the representations by passing a speaking order within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prayed to direct that no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

On the contrary, learned State counsel submits that there is no question of coercive action in the present case and in case, there is some FIR, it is his legal right to take legal remedies.

Given above, no orders are required to be passed regarding stay, but the concerned authorities shall behave in decent manner with the petitioner.
