The limited prayer made in this civil revision is for issuance of direction to the trial Court to decide an application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act for grant of maintenance filed by the petitioners against the respondent, which is stated to be pending since 24.2.2021.

Keeping in view the nature of the prayer, I do not find it necessary to issue notice of this civil revision to the respondent. Expeditious disposal of the case is a right of every litigant more particularly keeping in view the nature of the petition seeking maintenance by estranged wife and minor son from respondent – Naresh

Kumar Walia.

Therefore, the petition is disposed of directing Additional District Judge – cum – Principal Judge, Family Court, Chandigarh to decide the application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act filed by the revisionist/petitioners pending before her, now stated to be fixed for 15.3.2022, expeditiously within a period of six weeks from today, under intimation to this Court.
