The Appellate Court has dismissed the appeal on account of failure of the appellants to deposit the court fee. On 13.12.2017, notice of motion was issued as the learned counsel representing the petitioners contended that an application for permission to file the appeal as indigent person was not decided by the appellate court.

The learned counsel representing the respondent states that he has no knowledge of the aforesaid facts.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the order under challenge is conditionally set aside. If the application for filing an appeal as indigent person filed by the appellant remains undecided, the Appellate Court will at the first instance decide the application and thereafter, proceed with the matter.
