As per office report, respondent No.2 has been served, but there is no representation on her behalf.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.05 dated 10.01.2022, registered for offences under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Talwandi Chaudrian, District Kapurthala, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR, Annexure P-1, is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute and in compliance of order dated 15.02.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant, has joined the proceedings.

This fact has been confirmed by the State counsel upon instructions received from ASI, Gurdit Singh, who further submits that on completion of investigation, final report has been presented before the Trial Court.

In view of the above, but without examining the merits of the case, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 15.02.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
