The petitioner's application for restoration of a suit has been dismissed by the trial court on the ground that petitioner herein is a former Secretary of the Society, therefore, no application is maintainable on his behalf.

The suit was filed by as many as the following two plaintiffs:-

*“1. Gobind Vihar Residents Welfare Association (Regd.), Kansal Tehsil Kharar, Distt. SAS Nagar Mohali, through its Secretary Dr. Manu Sharma.*

*2. Dr. Manu Sharma Secretary son of Sh.D.R.Sharma resident of H.No.581, The Tribune Employees and Friends Welfare Society, Village Kansal, Tehsil Kharar, Distt. Mohali.”*

It is evident that Dr. Manu Sharma was plaintiff no.2. No doubt, he was referred to as Secretary, however, he had filed the suit as an individual. Once he is one of the plaintiffs, an application for restoration of the suit filed by him is maintainable. Consequently, the

order dated 18.08.2017 is set aside. The trial court is directed to decide the application on merits.

The revision petition stands allowed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
