1. This fourth petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 70, dated 7th April, 2020, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur, Punjab.
