The present petition has been filed under Section 439(2) read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to accused/private respondents vide common order dated 05.10.2021 passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.0781 dated 21.09.2021, under Sections 379/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar.

When this matter came up for hearing on 04.03.2022 before a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that the petitioner does not intend to press this petition on merits but since it was a dispute between father and daughter, there might be chances of an amicable settlement between the parties, and therefore, the prayer was made for summoning respondent No.4 for exploring the chances of amicable settlement, and therefore, notice of motion was issued only for this purpose by this Court. Thereafter, the petitioner did not deposit the process fee *qua*

respondent No.4 and this Court on 17.08.2022 noted that the Registry has reported that notice to respondent No.4 could not be issued for want of process fee and on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner one more opportunity was granted for deposit of process fee and it was directed that let fresh notice be issued to respondent No.4 on filing of process fee within a period of one week.

The Registry has now again reported that notice to respondent No.4 could not be issued for want of process fee.

Today, nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner and learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to file process fee twice.

In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
