Instant writ petition is at the hands of the Faridabad Industries Association assailing identically worded Memos dated 25.01.2022 at Annexure P-15 (colly) issued by the respondent/HSI IDC seeking payment of certain alleged default amount under the head “plot cost/enhancement cost”.

The writ petition had come up for preliminary hearing before this Court on 22.02.2022 and we had requested Mr. Ankur Mittal, learned counsel representing respondents No.2 to 5/Corporation to assist us.

During the course of resumed hearing today, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate has forwarded to the Bench a communication dated 03.03.2022 from the Deputy General Manager (Estate), HSI IDC and the same reads as follows:

Sub: Faridabad Industries Association vs. Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran and others (CWP-3281-2022). Demand of enhanced cost from Industrial Plot holders in various Sectors of Faridabad including Sector-58.

This has reference to order dated 22.02.2022 of Hon'ble High Court on the subject cited above.

In this regard, I am directed to say that enhancement for Industrial Estates transferred from HSVP to HSIIDC will be collected by the HSVP only. Accordingly, the Corporation has decided to withdraw the notices issued by HSIIDC/Corporation regarding demand of enhanced cost from Industrial Plot holders in various Sectors of Faridabad transferred from HSVP to HSIIDC including Sector-58, Faridabad.

A copy of such communication has also been furnished to counsel opposite.
