Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* quashing the impugned results dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) and 14.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) qua selection for the posts of Assistant Agriculture Engineer (Class-II). He claims that despite scoring more marks than the last selected candidate, he has not been called for interview.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuant to advertisement dated 28.12.2018, the petitioner had applied for the post of Assistant Agriculture Engineer (Class-II) under General category. He further submits that the petitioner was issued an admit card for the written examination. He qualified the same as per the list published by the respondent-Haryana Public Service Commission. However, candidates lower in merit, were though called for interview conducted on 24.01.2022 but not the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that qua his aforesaid grievance, petitioner also submitted a representation dated 18.01.2022 (Annexure P-5), but to no avail. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-Haryana Public Service Commission, on advance service, joins proceedings and states that competent authority shall take appropriate decision on the pending representation dated 18.01.2022 (Annexure P-5).

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, either way, by the competent authority on the pending representation dated 18.01.2022 (Annexure P-5), giving reasons thereof.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondent as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 18.01.2022 (Annexure P-5) and keeping in view the contention raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
