1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 24.10.2019, in CRM-M-45637-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M-45637-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into the grievances of the petitioner as raised by him in representation dated 07.10.2019 and take appropriate action as may be warranted in respect thereto, in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of orders Annexures R/1 to R/3 dated 25.12.2019, 29.10.2019 and 14.01.2020, recommending the cancellation of the FIR got registered by the petitioner, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order Annexures R/1 to R/3, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
