[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.07.2013, in CRM-M No.19998 of 2017 and order (Annexure P-2) dated 28.11.2016 passed by the learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that payment of maintenance as per entitlement in terms of the aforementioned orders has been released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
