[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 19.07.2019 in CWP No.19512 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.19512 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 12.03.2019 by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, today, learned AAG has produced copy of speaking order dated 18.08.2020. The same is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of the claim of the petitioner having been rejected, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge speaking order dated 18.08.2020 by way of appropriate proceedings in

accordance with law.

[4] The aforementioned course of action is not opposed to by the learned AAG.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
