1. The learned counsel for respondent No. 2 submits, that since in the main FIR, in respect whereof, quashing petition has been filed, on the basis of an apposite compromise, and, the petitioners have been granted leave to withdraw the said petition, with liberty to re-access this Court at an appropriate stage. Therefore, she submits that even in respect of the instant petition, the compromise as relied upon by all the concerned, be not, at this stage, be accepted, and, rather would be relied upon, but at an appropriate stage.

2. Consequently, the instant case is permitted to be withdrawn, at this stage.

3. However, liberty, is reserved to the petitoners to re-access this Court with the compromise concerned, but at an appropriate stage.
