Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.007 dated 07.01.2022 registered for offence under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Women Police Station, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR (Annexure P-1), which is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute, has been amicably settled and in compliance of order dated 21.07.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation. He submits that as Section 406 IPC has not been invoked, no recovery is to be effected from him.

Upon instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh, State counsel submits that petitioner has joined the investigation, he has cooperated with the investigation process and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

It deserves to be noticed that during pendency of the petition, matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court but the proceedings did not fructify.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 21.07.2022 is made absolute, subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
