This petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the notifications dated 22.04.2020, 24.12.2020 and 09.11.2020 (Annexures P-1, P-3 and P-4) being illegal arbitrary and unconstitutional. In this regard, the petitioner has already moved a representation/e-mail dated 06.12.2021 to the respondent-authorities which are still pending and no decision thereon has yet been taken.

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Haryana, on advance copy, submits that the aforesaid representation/e-mail dated 06.12.2021 filed by the petitioner shall be considered and decided by the authorities expeditiously in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, the petition stands disposed of.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and therefore, the respondent-authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
