1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 01.12.2021, in CWP No.24346 of 2021 in case titled as '**Sanjeev Mohindra versus The State of Punjab and others**'.

2. A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.24346 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 to take note of the representation filed by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if as per decision the petitioner was entitled for the amount in question, the same be paid to the petitioner within one month thereafter.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the issuance of notice to respondent No.4, the claim made by the petitioner in

05.03.2022 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition but may be granted liberty to challenge order dated 05.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against respondent No.4 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
