The petitioner had sought entry of mutation on the basis of an unregistered Will. The same was rejected as the Will was not proved. Appeal and revisions filed by the petitioner have also failed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon civil Court decree dated 23.04.2007 to submit that the authorities below were not justified in disbelieving the Will.

The argument is totally misconceived. The decree relied upon does not uphold the Will, on the contrary, the civil Court has found that succession must take place in accordance with the principles of natural succession.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
