Admittedly, the petitioners are not a party to the award passed by the Lok Adalat which was subsequently followed by the Court while passing a decree dated 19.11.2011. The revision petition is liable to be dismissed on the ground to delay and latches for a period of more than 10 years.

Furthermore, the petitioners allege fraud which can be established only by bringing some evidence on record.

Hence, the revision petition being wholly misconceived, is dismissed.
