Complaining wilful violation of the orders dated 03.12.2018 passed in CRM-M-53306-2018, the petitioner has filed the present petition under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The order dated 03.12.2018 reads as under:-

“This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct fair and proper impartial investigation and initiate necessary action against private respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to State of Haryana respondent No.1 consider and decide representation (Annexure P-4) within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Sh.J.S.Pannu, AAG, Haryana, states that a speaking order, as directed by the Court, has been passed on 08.07.2022, while considering the petitioner's representation.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
