While issuing notice of motion on 20.12.2017, the following
order was passed:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that
the suit itself was filed in the year 2017 in which list of
PWs was given on 03.11.2017.*

*Plaintiff-petitioner seeks one opportunity to
examine two witnesses i.e. the plaintiff herself and Mohd.
Sagir, Ahlmad of the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist
Class, Hisar.*

Notice of motion for 17.04.2018.

*In the meanwhile, trial Court shall adjourn the
proceedings beyond the date fixed by this Court.”*

Since then the proceedings before the trial Court have come to a
stand still.

Without commenting on the merits, it is considered appropriate
to grant one last opportunity to the plaintiff to conclude her entire evidence,
subject to the payment of Rs.5000/- as costs.

Both the counsels state that they are not aware of the current
status or the next date of hearing before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the trial court is requested to fix a date for production of the plaintiff's evidence within one month, from today. If the plaintiff fails to produce her entire evidence and there is no justification for further adjournment, the trial Court will proceed with the matter forthwith.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
