HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for the grant of increments to her late husband, who was working with the respondents-Department keeping in view the judgement passed by this Court in *Balwinder Singh and others versus State of Punjab and others reported as 1995 (3) RSJ page 31* and revise the pensionary benefits of her late husband and the consequential family pension.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in view the reply filed, all the benefits for which the petitioner became entitled for, have already been approved for release keeping in view the order passed by the respondents dated 24.03.2021 and no further grievance of the

petitioner survives.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the order dated 24.03.2021 has been passed but actual benefits have not been released to the petitioner in accordance with the said order and therefore, appropriate directions may kindly be given to the respondents to release the benefits to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the order Annexure R-1 has not been implemented in its letter and spirit so far, the needful will be done within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said undertaking of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
