SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for the search/release of detainee namely Neha, wife of the petitioner from the illegal custody of respondents No. 4 to 7.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 08.02.2022, order was passed with regard to appointment of Warrant Officer who shall visit the place where the detainee namely Neha was alleged to be detained illegally and get her released if found in illegal custody.

Report of the Warrant Officer has been received which is taken on record.

In the report, the Warrant Officer has mentioned that he went to the house of respondent No. 4 i.e. Devinder Kumar Aneja i.e. father of the alleged detainee and searched the house but she was not found in the house. He was told that the detainee is at her maternal grandparent's house (*Nanke*). The Warrant Officer talked with the

alleged detainee twice who stated that she knows the petitioner but his allegations with regard to her illegal confinement are not true and she is not being illegally detained and is living there at her own sweet will. She does not want to live or go with the petitioner.

Since, the alleged detainee-Neha is not being illegally detained and does not want to go or live with the petitioner, the present petition for release of detainee Neha has become infructuous.

Disposed of as having become infructuous.
