Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that though, the respondents have filed reply wherein, the applicability of the instructions issued in the year 2003/2004 by the respondents for regularization of the services is being disputed but nothing has come on record to show that the similarly situated employees have not been regularized by the respondents themselves.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that in the legal notice(s) served by the petitioner(s) upon the respondents details of the employees, who have been given the benefit of regularization of service and were similarly situated, have duly been mentioned and the petitioner(s) will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent-department to decide the said legal notice(s) by keeping in mind that the similarly situated employees have already been regularized.

Learned State counsel submits that though, as per the reply, no claim of the petitioner(s) exists but as the only prayer of the petitioner(s) made in the present petitions during the argument is for deciding their legal notice(s) on the ground that the similarly situated employees have been regularized, an appropriate order on the legal notice(s) served by the petitioner(s) will be passed by the respondent-department within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case after the decision, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to them within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, present petitions may

kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
