ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the final seniority list of Superintendent Institution Male/Female as it stood on 01.12.1999 (Annexure P-9).

2. Petition was admitted for hearing on 27.02.2003.

3. On the last date of hearing, none had put in appearance on behalf of petitioners, and Registry was directed to issue notice to learned counsel for petitioner for today. As per Office Report counsel for petitioner has been informed through email for the date fixed.

4. On resumed hearing, yet again, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even otherwise, it is important to note that a specific notice has been issued in the cause list, as well as, on the notice Board of the Court room, stating "*In the category of "To Be Taken Up" Regular matters shown in the daily cause list, if learned counsel still do not appear, it would be an indicator that they are not interested in pursuing the same and the cases shall then be decided regardless of their presence. Learned counsels*

are, therefore, requested to watch the regular cause list of the Court.”

Notwithstanding none appears. Court is left with no choice but to dismiss the petition in default.

5. Even otherwise by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for more than 20 years before this Court, either it has been rendered infructuous or even otherwise the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

6. Be that as it may, dismissed.
