Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.  
seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0007 dated 05.01.2022, under  
Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station  
Adarsh Nagar, District Faridabad.

Vide order dated 15.02.2022, this Court while granting  
the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to  
join investigation subject to the condition that the petitioner shall hand  
over a demand draft amount to Rs 2 Lakh in the name of the  
complainant to the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner has handed over the demand draft of Rs. 2 Lakh to the

Investigating Officer.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 15.02.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
