Through this petition, the petitioner is seeking cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, vide order dated 13.01.2022 in case FIR No.269 dated 21.08.2019 under Sections 420 read with Section 82 of the Registration Act, 1908 (Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana. He states that the Investigating Agency is not conducting the investigation properly as respondent No.2 is on anticipatory bail.

On a query, the learned State counsel submits that the report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C qua Harbans Singh-respondent No.2 shall be submitted to the Court positively within a period of one month from today.

Based on this assurance, the learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition.
