Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0009 dated 13.01.2021, under Sections 498-A, 354, 377, 406 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Central, Faridbad.

Vide order dated 26.07.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 26.07.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and parties appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court as well and the matter has been compromised.

Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2 affirms

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the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner. He, however, submits that some of the issues still remain to be settled.

The report of the Mediator dated 25.02.2022 confirming the settlement between the parties is also placed on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, from ASI Jagwati, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 26.07.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The parties are at liberty to negotiate the issues, if any remains to be settled between them.

Petition stands allowed.
