The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.235 dated 21.12.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506, 377, 34 IPC at Police Station, Ding, District Sirsa.

By virtue of the order dated 10.2.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that in pursuance to order dated 19.5.2022 both the parties duly appeared before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this court, however, same remained unsuccessful on account of the adamant behaviour of the petitioner. Report of the Mediator dated 5.7.2022 has also been placed on record affirming the fact that mediation proceedings remained unsuccessful.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in pursuance to order dated 10.2.2022 petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation. However, he submits that recovery of some gold articles is yet to be effected.

In view of the above, the order dated 10.2.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
