By this Writ Petition, the petitioners have challenged the action of the respondents for not cancelling the registration of the vehicles (which have otherwise been condemned).

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he will not press this petition on merits and would be satisfied if a direction be given to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 (Annexure P-14) within any reasonable time.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Bench, Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State of Punjab and states that she has no objection to this course of action.

5. In the circumstances, the present Writ Petition is disposed off

with a direction upon respondent No.2-Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Gurdaspur to decide the representation dated 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 (Annexure P-14) filed by the petitioners, in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
